NFA'S FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY PLANS REVIEW

This six day course will assist the student in verifying that construction documents comply with applicable building and fire codes for fire protection and life-safety requirements. Subjects addressed in the course include site plan reviews for emergency apparatus access, water supply, and hydrants for fire protection; review of architectural drawings for construction requirements, means of egress for life safety, and fire-resistive compartmentalization; evaluation of heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC), evaluation of exit illumination and emergency power supplies, and assessment of the need for built in fire protection systems and smoke control/management systems. Upon completion of course you will be receiving a certificate from the National Fire Academy.
